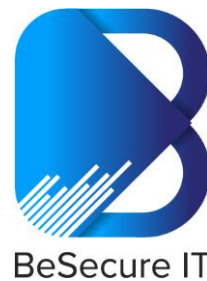


McAfee 3 Day Application Control and Change Control Course
